PRIMARY CARE : STUDIES IN SERVICE DELIVERY

Summary

This letter informs FPCs that the reports of the joint FPC/DHA studies of service delivery in Halton and Loughborough are now available.

1. The White Paper "Promoting Better Health" stated that the Government had set up two studies into "the way primary care services are being co-ordinated, planned and delivered". One, in Halton, was conducted by Cheshire FPC in collaboration with Halton DHA, the other in Loughborough, was conducted by Leicestershire FPC in collaboration with Leicestershire DHA.
