**BUILDING SUPERVISORS EMPLOYED BY HOSPITAL
MANAGEMENT COMMITTEES (ENGLAND AND WALES) AND
BOARDS OF MANAGEMENT (SCOTLAND)**

1. Agreement has been reached to an increase in the salary scales of building supervisors employed by Hospital Management Committees (England and Wales) and Boards of Management (Scotland). The new scales shown below replace, from 1st June, 1957, those set out in paragraph 4 (a) of P.T.B. Circular 61 with a consequent revision of the annual leave change point. All other provisions of P.T.B. Circular 61 remain effective.

2. *Salary Scales*

3. *Assimilation*

An officer on a scale set out in P.T.B. Circular 61 shall be assimilated as at 1st June, 1957, or the date of appointment if it was between the 1st June, 1957, and the date of this circular, to the point on the new scale corresponding to the point reached on his previous scale. His incremental date shall remain unchanged.

4. *Annual Leave*
